He has numerous publications in orthodontic and dental literature and has taught and lectured nationally and internationally for over forty years with the emphasis on functional occlusion and orthodontics. He is co-founder, and former co-director and faculty member of Advanced Education in Orthodontics (Roth/Williams USA) taught at the University of Detroit Mercy, School of Dentistry. Dr. Girardot has taught the Roth/Williams Philosophy of orthodontics for over 35 years and was recently co-faculty with Dr. Robert Williams at Roth/Williams Goal Directed Orthodontics, China. 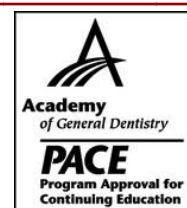
